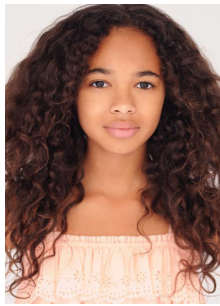
Tyler Foden – Fox's Untitled – **Lawrence/Halpern/Schumacker Pilot**

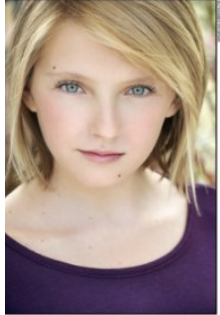
Griffin Gluck – ABC's Comedy Pilot, **Untitled Cullen Brothers' Project**

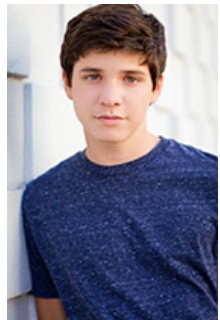
Chandler Kinney – CW’s Drama Pilot – *Company Town*

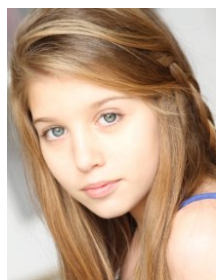
Kylie Rogers - NBC’s Comedy Pilot, *The Gates*

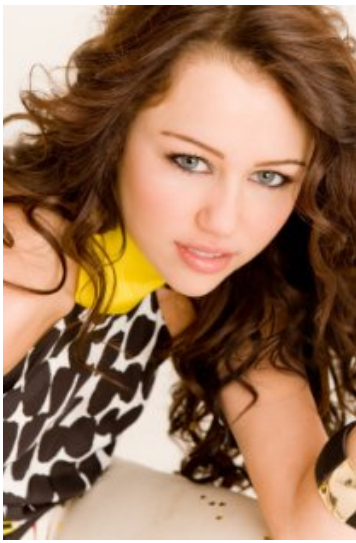


Blake Garrett Rosenthal – CBS’ Comedy Pilot, *Mom*
